Special thanks to Bob Morrow and Sue Cooper for hosting the Reserve Gourmet Group in June with a fabulous Hawaiian style Patio Party.

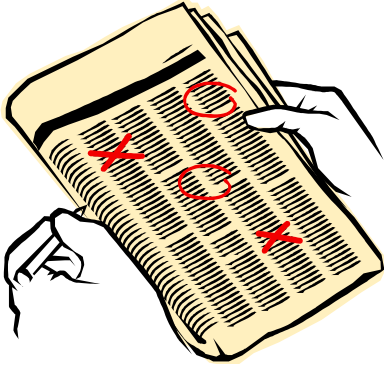
On August 1, Dennis Goik and Trudy Barnard will be hosting a Caribbean Island Party with delicious island recipes. T-shirts and flip-flops will be
